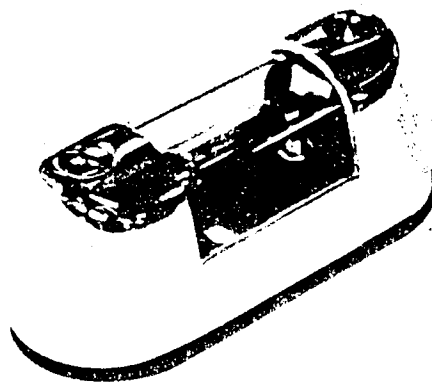

ABOUT THE NEW ALLIED SPREADER LIGHTS FOR THE SEABREEZE

I tried the new Allied Spreader lights designed for Allied boats (now available for \$9.25). The illumination is not as strong as the previous lights. Nevertheless, they interfere less with the mainsail setting and are easy to install on the spreader. They look very good. I recommend them highly.
