The cuisine is Northern Italian, but everything is cooked to order so requests to omit the garlic can be accommodated. No deposit is required and, on the basis of my guesstimate of about 20 people, a phone call on Monday the 5th and final confirmation on Friday will secure the tables. The restaurant is about six blocks from the exhibit hall and free parking is offered.
